Manchester After Hours returns for 2017 and, once again, we're looking for a dedicated team of friendly and outgoing volunteers to help to deliver the incredible events programme across the city.

This is your chance to get involved with Manchester's most ambitious one-night event of the year. On Thursday 18 May some of the city's biggest institutions stay open after hours for one-of-a-kind collaborations and activities, from experimental electronic music in Manchester's oldest building to Hey!Manchester's takeover of the Metroshuttle 2 bus, an immersive new audio-visual installation at the MSI from Islington Mill's Engine House Collective to specially commissioned spoken word from Bad Language at the beautifully-restored surroundings of Elizabeth Gaskell's

House, and much more.

Manchester After Hours has got it all going on – it's a one-night, city-wide social. It's chance for you to get into places and spaces not often open late; and here's how you can get involved: Creative Tourist are looking for a team of enthusiastic, friendly volunteers who have a passion for culture to help make this unique event happen. If successful, you will play a key role in delivering over 20 events in some of the city's greatest venues – and gain more experience working within the arts.

What's involved?

Our knowledgeable and friendly volunteers are placed at various city centre venues to hand out festival guides, direct people to the activity that might most take their fancy and support the event team with ad-hoc tasks. This requires a good knowledge of the city along with a knowledge of the event itself – you'll be the face of the festival and a key part of the vibrant atmosphere.

We are also seeking 1-2 individuals to provide voluntary social media support to help capture lots of content and images from the night itself. We want images, quotes, voice recordings – whatever takes your fancy! These will be shared to a central database and the team will disperse them accordingly from there. All volunteers must be available on the night of the festival: Thursday 18 May (from 3.30pm onwards preferably). There will also be a compulsory induction prior to the festival, on Monday 15 May at 6pm (venue TBC).
